carried 27 times for just 81 yards, but two touchdowns. Meanwhile the Bears behind Jahvid Best (24 carries, 111 yards, 1 TD) and Shane Vereen (9 carries, 111 yards, 1 TD) rushed for 203 yards and 2 TDs and kept the Spartans defensive line on its heels all game long.

Defensively, we got out of our gaps some. We faced a very good offensive lines; one of the better ones that we've seen, certainly since I've been here," he said. "Anytime you play a team like this, that's well coached, you'd better make sure that you're gap sound defensively. They forced us into some adjustments that we hadn't practiced, they got us out of our gaps a little bit and they creased us."

Adding to the Spartans defensive woes is the fact that MSU's front four of Dewayne Holmes, Justin Kershaw, Oren Wilson and Colin Neely couldn't generate a pass rush against the Bears either.

The Spartans also rotated in Trevor Anderson, Brandon Long, Kevin Pickelman, MSU had just one sack (Neely and Kershaw combined) against Cal's Kevin Riley who threw 20 for 30 for 264 yards and 2 touchdowns.

Expect the Spartans to work hard on keeping gap control against the Eagles this week in an attempt to force more plays to the linebacking corps that saw Greg Jones lead the team with eight tackles including two for loss.

The other two starters, Adam Decker (seven) and Eric Gordon (six) combined for thirteen. Ryan Allison who was the surprise of fall camp, did not record a tackle and played sparingly.

Dantonio Vows To Clean Up MSU “Heat Of the Moment” Penalties

EAST LANSING - Michigan State head football coach Mark Dantonio vowed that his team will clean up the “heat of the moment” penalties that plagued his team in their 38-31 season opening loss to California. While some have attempted to invoke the “same old Apartans” adage, referring to MSU penchant for drawing undisciplined penalties under former coaches Bobby Williams and John L. Smith, Dantonio said these were not undisciplined penalties.

“You look at penalties, and you ask, ‘which ones were unforced?’”, he asked. “How many times did we jump off-sides? Well (Justin) Kershaw jumped offsides but we had no delay of game penalties and I don't think we jumped offsides on offense.

Dantonio went on to describe how the difference between a penalty and a great play is all about the execution.

“Mark Dell goes up to make a play and they call him for interference. Not only is it an incomplete pass but it’s a 15-yard penalty. Roland’s (Martin) trying to cut [block] a guy and he misses the guy, hits another guy who’s already engaged and they call it a penalty.

We get a holding call. The guy (Cal’s Jahvid Best) runs a reverse, and he runs a 10.3 (forty time). We’re trying like crazy to get the guy down and I guess he grabs his face mask a little bit. [Another] guy’s tangled up with an all-American center and tries to get him off of him,” explained Dantonio.

“A lot of these are things that happened out there—some of them are judgement calls some of them are not. But you’ve got to play the game and play the situation out. Am I happy about it, no, absolutely not. But were not jumping offsides, we’re not doing those kinds of things.”

Dantonio doesn’t want to take away his team’s aggressiveness by overreacting, instead he talked about taking the action that made the most sense.

“What we have to do is correct the ‘heat of the moment’ penalties and get our hands down, you can’t grab a face mask, but couple of these things are difficult to assess because it’s sort of ...action...you know they happen in split seconds.”
